COSMIC CONFLICT: A 6-WEEK BIBLE STUDY SYLLABUS

A 6-Week Bible Study Series on Spiritual Warfare and the Unseen Realm

Purpose:

To equip believers with a biblical understanding of the supernatural world, tracing the theological and historical development of cosmic conflict from Genesis to Revelation. This study integrates Second Temple literature, Scripture, and Christ's victory to unveil the broader spiritual reality behind human history.

Week 1: Setting the Stage – The Unseen Realm and Divine Rebellion

- Key Texts: Deut. 32:8–9 (LXX/DSS), Psalm 82, Job 1–2
- Focus: Introduction to the Divine Council, cosmic geography, and supernatural rebellion
- Key Concepts: Elohim, delegated authority, divine agency

Week 2: Satan Unmasked – Tracing the Adversary's Development

- Key Texts: Job 1–2, Zech. 3:1–2, Rev. 12:7–10
- Focus: Development from *ha-satan* (accuser) to the New Testament Satan
- Key Concepts: Theological consolidation, courtroom role, serpent/dragon imagery

Week 3: Watchers and the Sons of God – Rebellion Before the Flood

- Key Texts: Gen. 6:1–4, Jude 6, 2 Pet. 2:4, 1 Enoch 6–16
- Focus: The sin of the Watchers, origin of demons, and pre-flood spiritual corruption
- Key Concepts: Nephilim, transgression of boundaries, theological use of 1 Enoch

Week 4: Divine Judgments and Cosmic Fallout

- Key Texts: Gen. 11:1–9, Deut. 32:8–9, Acts 17:26–27
- Focus: Babel and the disinheritance of the nations; Israel as God's remnant
- Key Concepts: Cosmic geography, divine allotment, missional theology

Week 5: Angels and Demons – Agents in the Conflict

- Key Texts: Dan. 10:12–21, Eph. 6:12, 1 Enoch 15
- Focus: The structure of spiritual hierarchies and their roles in biblical conflict
- Key Concepts: Territorial spirits, principalities and powers, angelology/demonology

Week 6: Christ's Victory – The End of the Conflict

- Key Texts: Col. 2:13–15, Eph. 1:20–23, Rev. 20:1–10
- Focus: Christ's triumph over spiritual powers and the restoration of divine order
- Key Concepts: Christus Victor, inaugurated eschatology, reclaiming the nations

Each session includes:

- Biblical and Second Temple literature exploration
- Group discussion and reflection
- Application to spiritual life and warfare
- Take-home journaling or prayer challenges
- Defined theological terms for clarity
