

## **GOD'S COSMIC COUNCIL – A 6-WEEK BIBLE STUDY SYLLABUS**

### **Overview:**

This study introduces participants to the Divine Council Worldview (DCW), inviting them to recover the Bible's original supernatural context. Through key Old and New Testament passages, participants will understand the nature of spiritual beings, the structure of the unseen realm, and their role in God's redemptive mission to reclaim the nations.

### **Week 1: Re-Enchanting the Bible**

**Theme:** Recovering the Supernatural Worldview

**Key Texts:** Psalm 82; Job 1:6–12; 1 Kings 22:19–23

**Focus:**

- The biblical worldview assumes a populated spiritual realm.
- Introduces the concept of a Divine Council of spiritual beings.
- Challenges the modern "disenchanted" reading of Scripture.

**Key Terms:** Divine Council, elohim, disenchantment

### **Week 2: Yahweh Among the gods**

**Theme:** Biblical Monotheism vs. Modern Assumptions

**Key Texts:** Deuteronomy 32:8–9 (LXX/DSS); Psalm 89:5–7; Deuteronomy 10:17

**Focus:**

- “Elohim” refers to various spiritual beings—not just Yahweh.
- Yahweh is unique, supreme, and uncreated among all spiritual powers.
- Understanding monolatry in ancient Israelite theology.

**Key Terms:** Monolatry, El Elyon, divine hierarchy

### **Week 3: Cosmic Rebellion**

**Theme:** Tracing the Three Rebellions

**Key Texts:** Genesis 3:1–15; Genesis 6:1–4; Genesis 11:1–9

**Focus:**

- Sin entered the world through both human and divine rebellion.
- Genesis reveals three key moments of cosmic fracture.
- Sets the stage for understanding demonic origins and national disinheritance.

**Key Terms:** Watchers, Nephilim, Tower of Babel

---

## **Week 4: Seeing with Two Lenses**

**Theme:** The Dual-Lens Hermeneutic

**Key Texts:** Hosea 11:1 / Matthew 2:15; Amos 9:11–12 / Acts 15:16–17

**Focus:**

- The apostles interpreted the Old Testament in light of Christ.
- Scripture has both original context and Spirit-led fulfillment.
- Encourages a faithful yet Christ-centered hermeneutic.

**Key Terms:** Typology, reapplication, *sensus plenior*

---

## **Week 5: The Cosmic Gospel**

**Theme:** Christ's Victory in the Heavenly Realm

**Key Texts:** Colossians 2:15; Ephesians 6:12; Acts 2:1–11

**Focus:**

- Jesus' victory disarmed spiritual rulers and powers.
- Pentecost marked the reversal of Babel's disinheritance.
- The Gospel reclaims both people and territory for God's kingdom.

**Key Terms:** Principalities and powers, spiritual warfare, kingdom reclamation

---

## **Week 6: Living the Story**

**Theme:** Participating in the Divine Drama

**Key Texts:** Matthew 28:18–20; Romans 6:3–5; Ephesians 1:21–23

**Focus:**

- Believers are active agents in the mission to reclaim the nations.
- The Church continues Christ's cosmic victory.
- Our lives reflect and advance God's kingdom agenda.

**Key Terms:** Ecclesiology, mission, resurrection power
